Born January 6th, 1946 at Sultanbad, Iran. In 1947 he moved with his family to Erevan in Armenia in the Soviet Union. In 1968 he graduated from the Computer Technical College at Erevan and was subsequently employed in the Erevan Computer Institute. In 1969 he entered the Academy of Fine Arts of the Artistic-Theatrical Institute at Erevan where he studied for three years. In 1971 he moved to Poland and began studying at the Polish Academy of Arts, Warsaw, during the school year 1972/73. In 1975 he obtained a diploma in the faculty of painting.
